## NUMERACY CHALLENGE

May month will be our NUMERACY MONTH. We have set a challenge for all the grades as below.

**JK:-** Kids will be doing a number scavenger hunt, Counting Nos 1 to 50, Adding and Subtracting up to 5 and Word Problems.

**Bonus Points:-** Skip counting 2s, 5s, 10s, Reverse counting from 20, Addition Subtraction up to 10.

**K:-** Counting till 100. Skip counting by 2 upto 50, Skip counting by 10 up to 100. Adding and subtracting up 10 and Word Problems.

**Bonus Points:-** Counting backward from 20 and 50 would be a bonus. Double Digit Addition and Subtraction.

**G1:-** Times tables 1-5, Word Problems, Double Digit Addition/Subtraction

**Bonus Points:-** Multiplication using 2 to 5 tables, Tables upto 10.

**G 2/3 :-** Grade 2 Kids will do a multiplication and division to (1-5) and Grade 3's (1-10). This also means memorizing tables. Grade 2s up to 1-5 and Grade 3s 1-10 tables. Along with this they will focus on basic addition and subtraction math facts with addends to 10.

**Bonus Points G2:-** Tables upto 10, Double digit Multiplication and Division

**Bonus Points G3:-** Tables upto 20, Multiplication and Division using tables upto 20.
