

Gobind Sarvar School - Edmonton, AB Uniform Policy

There are a number of reasons as to the significance of a school's uniform. One of the most prominent being that, in part of being an academic school, the uniform is intended to direct our student's attention on the pursuit of excellence instead of the pursuit of the latest fashion. Additionally, the uniform reinforces the school's individuality and identity as well as implants the attitudes and orientation which the school aims to achieve and portray in its students.

At Gobind Sarvar School, it is a part of the student code of conduct for all students to wear the school uniform outlined in the school agenda. There is the regular academic uniform, which is expected to be worn by students on a daily basis. Additionally, the school provides a uniform for Physical Education, where teachers will inform students and parents on which days they must wear them (see below).

- Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday: White Shirt, Grey Pant/Tunic, Bow or Tie, Belt, Maroon Head cover, Maroon Sweater/ Blazer(weather permitted), black/grey socks(girls can wear black leggings with Tunic)
- Thursday White Polos/ Maroon T-shirts/Sweatshirts with Grey Sweatpants
- Friday White Bana or any of the above pieces of uniforms
- Maroon Head covering is mandatory all the times

It is an expectation that students present themselves modestly and neatly. To avoid any mix-up with another student's article of clothing, it's always a good idea to label a student's name on the inner tag with a permanent marker (ex. a Sharpie marker). Students **MUST** arrive at school each day dressed in their full uniform. Parents and students are responsible to ensure that students are dressed appropriately in every aspect of their uniform, including everything from properly tied shoe laces to a clean and tucked-in white shirt. **Any violation of the school uniform will result in the following:**

1. First Reminder

The teacher will have the right to send a student to the office for their "first-uniform slip", which will also include an email to their parents.

2. Second Reminder

The teacher will send the students to the office, where the office will require the student to call home or have their parents bring them the missing uniform item. Failure to bring the student's article of clothing will result in the student leaving the school for the day. Students are able to return to class after notifying their parents as they wait for them to bring the required clothing.

3. Third Reminder

The teacher sends the student to the office, where the student will be required to call

home to have their parents pick them up for the day or bring them the appropriate

uniform. Students may not return to class to wait for their parents, they must only return

when they have received the appropriate clothing and will wait in the office until

conditions are fulfilled.

To purchase a school uniform, it is the responsibility of the parents to bring their children to the

school to try on different articles of clothing to determine which size suits them best. Hence, all sales are

final and there will be no refunds or exchanges in any situation, therefore ensure that the size that is

purchased is correct to that of your child. School uniforms will be available for purchase on the last

Thursday of each month, and won't be available within the time in between, so it is the responsibility of

the parents to adhere to these conditions and ensure that their child's uniform is purchased on the

designated day. Additionally, the office will not be sending uniform articles home with students upon

the requests of parents. Therefore, parents must make an effort to arrive at the school on the designated

day with their children to ensure the following conditions are met:

a. The student has every article of clothing required to adhere to the school's uniform policy

b. Each article of clothing is suitable for the students (ex. sizing is correct)

c. To acknowledge that failure to adhere to the school's uniform policy will result in the

enforcement of the school's Protocol of Uniform Violations (see above).
